NEW LAWS IN FALL 2016, GRADES 1-4: No punting allowed. Build Out Line - When GK has possession, opposing team has 6 seconds to drop and stay behind the build out line until the GK puts the ball in play. GK may play ball immediately or wait for opposing team to drop. If opposing team takes longer than 6 second to drop or crosses the line before GK puts ball in play, warn the coach. If delays continue despite warnings, issue a yellow card to the coach. Restart - IFK at the point of offense on Build Out Line

Slaughter Rule – Applies to all divisions. A team losing by 4 goals may add a player. For each additional 2 goals scored by the leading team, the other team may add another player. When the losing team has exhausted its roster, the leading team must remove a player each time the losing team is eligible to add player(s). The losing team must remove a player each time the above conditions are not met.

Substitutions are allowed, with permission of the referee, in the following situations:

- **Kindergarten / 1**st **Grade**: on any stoppage in play.
- Grades 2-8:
 - On either team's throw-in (i.e. white may sub on blue throw-in), delay of game not permitted.
 - o On either team's goal kick.
 - After a goal has been scored.
 - o After an injury with a stoppage in play (any number of subs by both teams).
 - o After a player receives a yellow card (only that player may be subbed).
